Mr. Bhaskar Pramanik



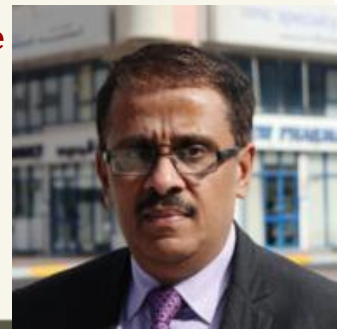
