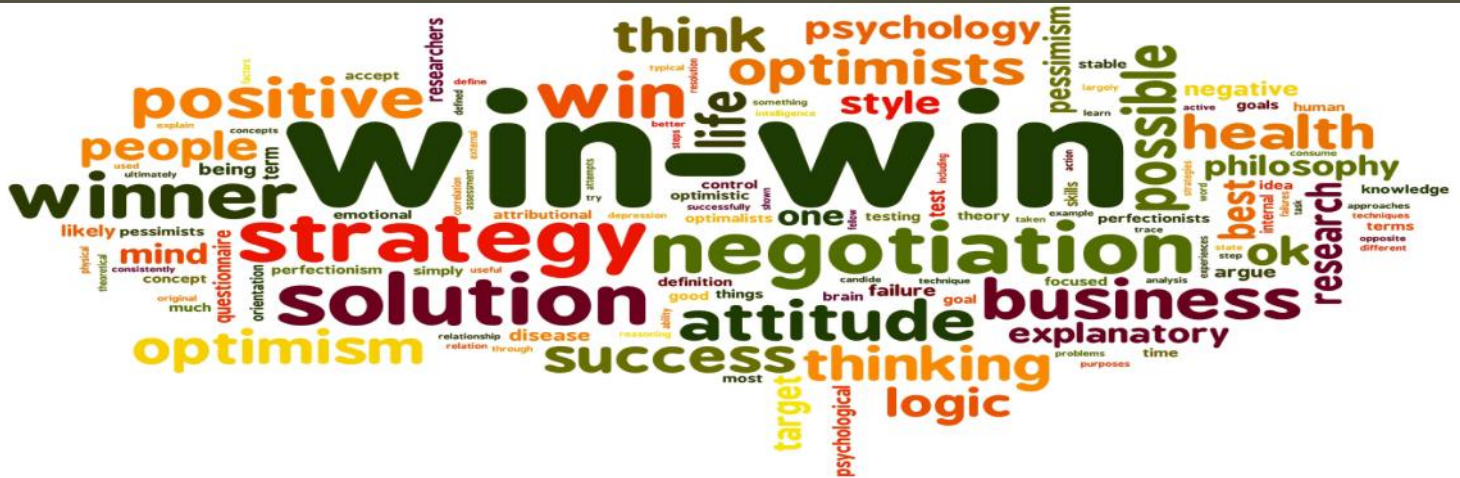




# PRESENTS NEGOTIATING SKILLS
