

Scholarship at AIT, Bangkok for Professional Masters in Banking and Finance

The Professional Masters in Banking and Finance Programme at AIT is happy to announce two scholarships for participants from the banking industry in Nepal through National Banking Institute in the 7th batch due to commence in September 2019. Participants can expect to complete the programme in August 2020.

Typically, participants are working bankers with over 5 years of work experience. They must have a bachelor's degree from a recognized university.

The scholarship will cover the tuition fees of 18,820 USD. Participants or their sponsors will have to bear the living expenses (lodging, food and other related expenses). The expected accommodation and living expense per year shall be in the range of approximately US\$ 7000.

The curriculum focuses on Economics, Finance and Banking. More information about the programme structure, faculty and eligibility criteria can be found at www.bankingandfinance.ait.asia.

Entry Requirement:

To be eligible for admission to the programme, a candidate should have:

- A Bachelor's degree or equivalent, in a relevant discipline. The minimum GPA requirement for admission to the Master's Program is 2.75 or equivalent at the Bachelor degree level.
- Relevant work experience of at least 5 years in banking and finance at minimum officer level
- IELTS scores of 6.0 (or higher) or pass AIT English Entry Test. (The AIT Entry Test shall be conducted post your application procedure).

Candidates will be required to take an admission test and appear for an interview. The preparatory program may be recommended for potential candidates based on the performance in the admission test.
